PRESCHOOL & CHILDREN'S MINISTRY FAITH STEP PLAN

We begin welcoming children into our faith community at birth and continue to value their presence and participation as they grow. We understand the importance of teaching children about God from an early age, and we strive to provide a learning environment that is safe, loving and developmentally appropriate. At DBC we focus attention on teaching our families to Love God, Love People, Make Disciples, and Make a Difference. Through worship, study, fellowship, and service, we are dedicated to providing preschoolers and children with a solid foundation for their spiritual journey.

This booklet outlines the basics of faith which we as a community of faith want to teach our preschoolers through 5th graders. These faith steps will lead our children and their families to a better understanding of what is available for them to learn while they attend DBC. We desire to attain a partnership with families as we lay the foundation of faith.

This year we will be using GO! curriculum in the Sunday school hour. The GO! curriculum covers a Scope and Sequence for a total of three years. Each year begins in August and takes kids on a chronological journey through the entire Bible with different stories and with a different emphasis. During the 2021-2022 ministry year, kids will see and experience both God's power and promises through the Big Bible Story, but there will be a special emphasis on God's people. God's story of grace and redemption through His Son, Jesus, is told both to people and through people. Kids will discover that God has invited them to be His people and to share His story with the world. There will be glimpses of God's salvation plan throughout the year, but there will be four lessons where that plan is communicated clearly and kids will have an opportunity to respond.

During the 11 am worship hour, DBC Kids Worship will be using LifeChurch kids curriculum and following along a chronological journey of God's Story. On Wednesday evenings, our children have the opportunity to dig deeper into God's Word through missions, music, and special topics with Mrs. Bridgette (Grades K-5) and Mrs. Tawnya (4's and Young 5's).

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MEANINGFUL INVOLVEMENT

Faith development occurs through learning God's Story as well as meaningful involvement within the life of the church. The next section of this resource describes experiences we want every child to encounter.

1. Our children will lead in worship:

We believe our children should have the opportunity to participate in worship through singing, prayers, reading of scripture and sharing their musical and dramatic gifts. God has gifted each person differently and we will seek to find a way for each child to serve. A child who attends worship regularly will be more comfortable with taking a leadership role. We help children become familiar with worship words and their meaning.

2. Our children understand the meaning and importance of our church ordinances:

We observe two ordinances at DBC, Baptism and Communion. One of the most important steps a new believer can take is the step of baptism. Baptism signifies the beginning of new life and testifies to the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Communion is a way of remembering Jesus' sacrifice of his life for each of us. Jesus' body was broken and his blood shed for the forgiveness of sin. The bread represents Jesus' body and the cup represents the blood shed for us. Communion is reserved for those who have made their profession of faith. Children will attend a New Beginnings class to facilitate a better understanding of making their decision to follow Christ.

3. Our children are familiar with songs in worship:

Our children have the opportunity to join Kids Choir in order to learn, practice and lead the congregation in worship songs. These songs will be foundational in their understanding of how lyrics tie closely to scripture. Our children in grades K-5 have the opportunity to learn music during Kids Choir every Wednesday in the Children's Rally Room from 6:45-7:30 pm.

4. Our children understand what it means to make a difference in our community and beyond:

People of all ages can serve others. It is our belief the younger we start serving the more empathy towards others we will attain. Our children participate in a variety of mission opportunities throughout the year. Our children have the opportunity to serve others regularly on Wednesdays from 6-7 pm in the Children's Rally Room.

5. Our children participate in a church-related camp or retreat:

We believe children need opportunities to grow in their faith by attending church-related camps or retreats. Such camps build relationships with other children of our church as well as make new friends with other Christ followers. Our children have the opportunity to attend DBC Kids Camp, Camp Unite and Camp All-American each summer.

- Make a Difference

PRESCHOOL LESSONS

AUGUST: Angry Words - Speak Kind Words

Our words can hurt people or bring joy to people. We can do things God's way-listening to others, not speaking in anger, and telling others about Jesus.

September: I Can Help - Following Jesus, Helping Others

During the preschool years little ones are learning how to be helpers: to their parents, their teacher and their friends. Kids will learn that helping others is one of the ways that we can follow Jesus.

October: Pumpkin Patch

Preschoolers will learn about the plan God has for all of us using pumpkins.

November: I Can Say Thank You - Always Say Thank You

In life, we can choose to grumble and be selfish, or we can choose to be grateful. Every day, we should praise God and give Him thanks.

December: Journey to Bethlehem - Follow the Star

Come see who is in the manger. God brought very different people together in Bethlehem to celebrate the birth of Jesus. Little ones will learn that Jesus is the reason we celebrate Christmas.

January: How to Train your Attitude - The Right Attitude Pleases God

When we have a good attitude, everything seems better. God help us with our attitude. We want to live in a way that pleases God.

February & March: Jesus Fixed It! - Jesus' Amazing Miracles

Every single person has done or said bad things. These bad things - like lying, disobeying our parents, or saying mean things - are called "sin". Sin keeps us from being close to God. In this series, little ones will examine the 7 miracles of Jesus recorded in the book of John—as well as the resurrection—to understand that: Jesus came to "fix it". Jesus came to fix our damaged relationship with God, so that we can be with God forever in heaven.

April: Easter Eggs - Finding Jesus' Love

Kids get excited about seeking out the hidden eggs on Easter morning. By looking at Easter eggs, preschoolers will learn about what Jesus did at Easter to seek us out and show us His love.

May: Book of the Bible - Introducing Little Ones to God's Story

While preschool may be too soon to expect kids to memorize all 66 books of the Bible, we can still introduce kids to those books and help them see how they work together to tell us God's story.
